Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 91 residents and 61 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We continue bi-weekly testing based on the county positivity rate which is currently 9%. Our last facility-wide testing was on March 1, 2021 for residents and staff. We have had 61 staff recover and 85 residents. We had 1 staff member tested positive on Feb 24, 2021 and is currently isolating at home.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Walgreens was here on January 13, 2021 and administered the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. All residents and staff who consented to vaccine received the Pfizer vaccine. The 2nd dose of vaccine was administered on February 3, 2021. Our last COVID-19 vaccine clinic was held on Feb 24, 2021.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
